

Hampstead Garden Suburb Residents Association  
Minutes of a Special General Meeting  
held on 6 June 2006 at Fellowship House at 8.00pm

A motion was proposed by John Boulter, Hon Treasurer and seconded by Richard Wakefield, Hon Secretary.

'That the Association raises its suggested minimum subscription to £10 or £12 or £15 depending on the choice of the Meeting'

The Chairman explained that at the Annual General Meeting of the Association on 27 March 2006, a discussion had taken place about an increase in the annual recommended subscription. The majority of residents present had expressed the view that the subscription should be increased to £15 but as notice had not been given to residents of this proposal a Special General Meeting was needed.

The Hon Treasurer explained the background to this proposal and how the subscription had not increased with inflation and the value of the £3 subscription in 1970 was £30 today. The subscription would remain a recommended subscription and residents who are unable to pay this amount may pay what they can afford.

It was suggested that in future at each Annual General Meeting, there should be an Agenda item to discuss whether the subscription should remain the same or be raised.

A Motion 'To increase the suggested minimum subscription to £15' was put to the members and it was passed by 37 votes in favour and 3 against. Fifty five members attended the meeting.
